GENERAL INFORMATION

Installation

In all contract locations an 'all over' stick down method is recommended to BS 5325 (1983). If underlay is required it should be of a firm and unyielding type and where installed in larger contract areas the carpet should be power stretched. If exact colour matching is required for a quantity order, please state this point clearly when ordering.

Maintenance

To maintain your carpet's appearance it is recommended that it is vacuumed at least three times per week, to remove particles of dirt and dust. An upright vacuum with beater bar and brush is recommended for use with cut pile carpets.

Please note, over time, regular foot traffic will flatten the pile surface in the main walkways, causing areas of differential wear. These areas will appear lighter or shaded in comparison to the less frequently used parts. This shading / tracking or flattening happens to all carpets with a pile surface and as such is not accepted as the basis for any complaint. Similarly Pile Reversal (or watermarking) is a phenomenon that can affect all cut pile carpets and as such is not accepted as a manufacturing fault.

Matching

This sample may not be from the same production batch as current stock and therefore should be used as a guide and not as an exact match. Equally matching between 5 metre and 4 metre widths cannot be guaranteed.

Important

Minimum order length is 1.5 metres.
